tranquil heart we be content with everything as he

disposes and arranges it for us, that we do not want times and places according to our liking but only to God's. When we are thus stripped of our every wish and clothed in God's will, we are very pleasing to God.

(The Letters of St Catherine, Volume 1, Letter T 132, 201/2)

It is a succinct description of the interior life. Those who accept God's embrace are stripped metaphorically of their outer clothing. They are being prepared for heaven.


I will be away for a few days (midweek) from Monday 29<sup>th</sup> April returning Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> May.
